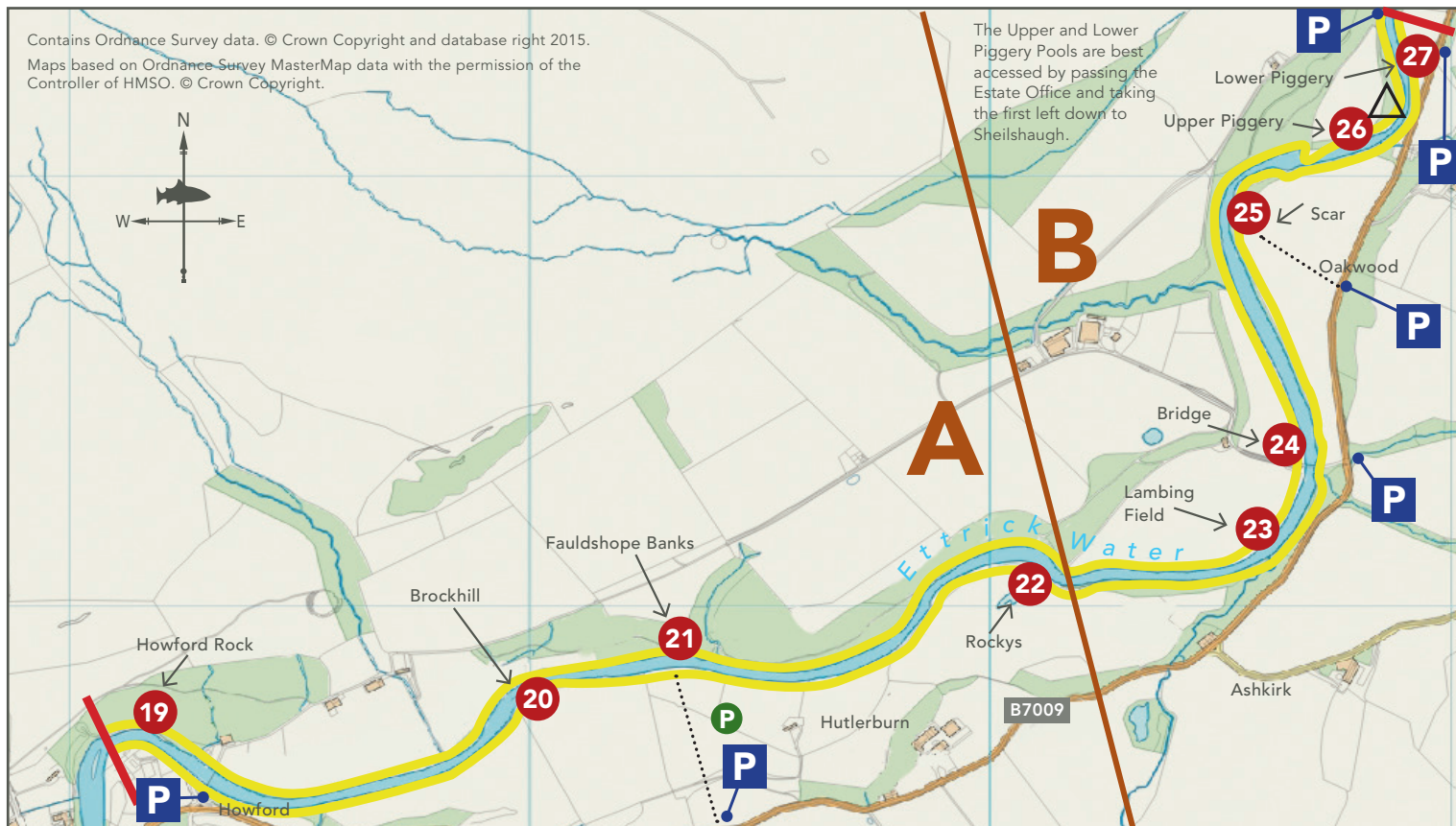




BEAT 4 BROCKHILL

A beat benefiting from double banked fishing. Although challenging to fish due to its fragmented pools, each pool is very good with high potential.

HIGH WATER

Rods: 13' or 14'.

Lines: Either an intermediate or floating line with interchangeable tips.

Flies: Cascade, Willie Gun, Shrimps, Small Cone Heads, 8s & 10s double or treble.

LOW WATER

Rods: Either switch rod or 10s single handed rod.

Lines: As above.

Flies: Posh Tosh, Cascade, Very small tubes ½" long. Silver Stoa, Shrimps, 10s & 12s double or treble.
